### FRIDAYS B.C.A. Spirit Day

- Girls: Khaki pants/shorts with B.C.A. T-shirt and sneakers. Also, B.C.A. sweatpants/sweatshirts permitted.
- Boys: Khaki pants/shorts with B.C.A. T-shirt and sneakers. Also B.C.A. Sweatpants/sweatshirts permitted.

## DRESS CODE POLICY

### COLD WEATHER DAYS

On days when the temperature falls below 55 degrees, students may wear a heavier jacket (NAVY, BLACK OR BURGUNDY ONLY) along with the BCA SWEATER. In winter months, white cotton turtleneck shirts are acceptable. All other days, the B.C.A. SWEATER IS REQUIRED. NO OTHER LIGHT JACKETS AND/OR SWEATERS PERMITTED.

**IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PARENT TO REPLACE ANY LOST ITEMS OR THE UNIFORM AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.**

### GROOMING

1. Belts. Any clothing with belt loops, must be worn with a belt. (Black or brown only)
2. All shirts/blouses must be tucked in. A sloppy look is not acceptable for boys or girls.
3. All skirts and jumpers must be long enough to cover the midriff when hands are raised.
4. Headbands, neckbands, sweatbands and other distracting accessories are not permitted.
5. Jewelry.

Boys: No jewelry permitted.

Girls: Stud earrings only. No other jewelry permitted.

6. Hair.

Boys: Neat, clean and well groomed. No words, designs, numbers, rat-tails or different colors permitted.

Girls: Accessories in colors, which coordinate with the uniform the student is wearing.

7. Shoes must be worn at all times.
